In the 1990s she moved to the US and hosted a television series to over 75 million homes on the EWTN cable network. In 1997 Dana was the first-ever independent candidate nominated to contest Ireland's presidential election. She shocked the political establishment by gaining 15 per cent of the popular vote. Two years later she was successful in being elected, against all the odds, as a Member of the European Parliament for Connacht/Ulster. From a childhood in the Bogside of Derry, through the maelstrom of international showbiz, to the White House and the Vatican, to the European Parliament and all its political intrigue, Dana's story is truly astonishing.
